“Our response to such statements is more than mere theological discussion. Confidence in the sovereignty of GOD in *all* that affects us is crucial to our trusting Him. *If there is a single event in all of the universe that can occur outside of GOD’s sovereign control then we cannot trust Him.* His love may be infinite, but if His power is limited and His purpose can be thwarted, we cannot trust Him. You may entrust to me your most

- **God controls *all things*** – those things that *greatly* influence our daily decisions:
 - To whom we would be born.
 - In what country we would be born.
 - God controls our wealth – who will be rich and who will be poor.
 - God controls the weather.
 - God moves armies in and out of countries.
 - God promotes and demotes.
 - God decides when, where, and how we will die.
 - God decides our health and our abilities. (consider Exodus 4:11)
 - God is the One who gives us our leaders and governments.
 - God has controls over terrorists.
 - God even has control over *accidental* deaths. (Exodus 21:13)
 - God controls the tongue.
 - God moves people to fulfill His Word. (Revelation 17:17; Matthew 21:1-5; and all the places in the NT where it says, “this happened so that Scriptures might be fulfilled.”
 - God opens and closes doors. (Acts 14:27; Acts 16:6-9, Acts 16:26; 1 Cor. 16:9; 2 Cor. 2:12; Colossians 4:3; Revelation 3:7-8)
 - If we have *anything* (wealth, faith, education, health, etc.) *all* comes from God. (1 Corinthians 4:7)
 - God controls the heart. (Proverbs 21:1; Psalm 105:25; Deut. 2:30; Exodus 10:1; Joshua 11:19-20; Ezra 7:27-28)

“Complaining about the weather is complaining about GOD!” “Complaining about the weather is sin!” (Numbers 11:1) “Whether the weather merely disrupts my plans or destroys my home, I need to learn to see GOD’s sovereign and loving hand controlling it.”
