



We Are Living in Dangerous Times

(Ephesians 5:14-16)

- The 21st Century “church” has grown “fat” and has forgotten their LORD. (Deut 31:20; 32:15)
- The 21st Century “church” is following the same course as God’s people in the Old Testament. (Jeremiah 6:16-17)
- In the 21st Century we “pick and choose” what we **want** to believe and **how** we want to obey. (1 Samuel 15:10-23; Romans 10:3)
- In the 21st Century, we believe that as long as we believe that Jesus died for my sins I am going to heaven. I have no other obligations, demands, commands, etc. to be concerned with. (1 John 2:3-6, 9; James 2:14-26; Hebrews 5:9)
- In the 21st Century, we believe only full time workers are obligated to give their ALL to God. (Luke 14:26-33; Philippians 3:7-8)
- In the 21st Century, we do not believe that Church is to be the number one priority in our lives. (Ephesians 1:15-23; 4:12; 5:23-32; 1 Cor 12:12-27; Colossians 1:18; Romans 12:4-5)
- In the 21st Century, we do not believe that we have to take God literally at His commands. (John 14:15, 21, 23-24; 15:10, 13-14; 1 John 2:3-4)
- In the 21st Century, many have departed, are departing, and will depart from **the** faith. (1 Timothy 4:1; 2 Timothy 3:1-5; 4:4; 2 Thessalonians 2:3)
- In the 21st Century, many have been, are being, will be deceived in putting their trust in a counterfeit gospel. (Galatians 1:6-9; Matthew 24:4-5, 11, 24)
