

What Mercies?

“... by the mercies of GOD ...”

(Romans 12:1)

One might paraphrase Paul, “Because God’s mercies, as I have outlined in the previous chapters, are true and we, the saints, have been recipients of these mercies, **this is how we must now live.**”

- ★ (1:5) Recipients of God’s grace
- ★ (1:6) **Called** of Jesus Christ.
- ★ (1:7) “beloved of God”
- ★ (1:7) “saints” – “holy ones”; “those who have been **set apart** by God”
- ★ (3:24) “**justified freely** by His grace” (4:24; 5:1, 9, 18)
- ★ (3:24) **Redeemed** by Christ.
- ★ (3:25) Christ propitiating God’s anger towards us.
- ★ (4:7) Sins forgiven.
- ★ (4:8) Our sins **not imputed** unto our accounts!
- ★ (4:22-25) God’s righteousness **imputed** unto our account!
- ★ (5:1) **Peace** with God.
- ★ (5:9) Saved from God’s **wrath**.
- ★ (5:10-12) **Reconciliation** with God. (2 Corinthians 5:18)
- ★ (6:7) **Freed** from the power of sin.
- ★ (6:23) The **gift** of **eternal life** in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- ★ (8:1) **NO CONDEMNATION!**
- ★ (8:4) The righteous requirement of the Law **fulfilled** in us.
- ★ (8:14-16) From **enemies** to **children** of God.
- ★ (8:17) **Heirs** of God.
- ★ (8:17) **Co-Heirs** with Christ.
- ★ (8:26) The intercession of the Holy Spirit.
- ★ (8:28) God **working** all things for our good.
- ★ (8:29-30) The **Golden Chain of GRACE!**



- ★ (8:29) **CHOSEN** by God. (Ephesians 1:4; Romans 9:10-24)
 - God’s sovereign grace and mercy bestowed on us by His will – NOT ours!
- ★ (8:29) **PREDESTINED** by God. (Ephesians 1:5-6, **11**)
- ★ (8:29) God working to **conform** us into the image of Christ.
- ★ (8:30) **CALL by GOD Himself.**
- ★ (8:30) **JUSTIFIED** by God, the Judge of All the Earth, the MOST HIGH!
 - (8:33) No one can bring a charge **against** us!
- ★ (8:30) **ALREADY GLORIFIED!** (Ephesians 2:6)
- ★ (8:34) Christ’s **intercession**. (Hebrews 7:25)
- ★ (8:35-39) **Inseparable** from the love of God.
- ★ (10-11) God moving in history in order that we, Gentiles, might be saved.
- ★ (11:29) The **irrevocable** gifts and calling of God.
