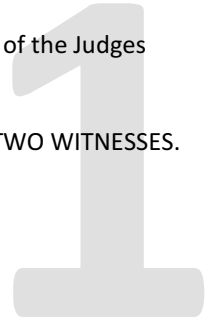
Course: A Survey of the Bible: Genesis to Revelation

Lesson: 10 (Part 4)

Passage: Deuteronomy - Survey

Various Laws (Deuteronomy 14-26)

- (Deuteronomy 14) Law of Food
 - ★ (v. 2) YOU ARE A HOLY (Set Apart) PEOPLE CHOSEN BY GOD FOR HIMSELF.
- (Deuteronomy 14 & 26) Law of the Tithe
 - ★ (Deut 14:22) You shall truly tithe ALL the increase of your grain . . .
 - ★ (Deut 14:27-29) You shall not forsake the Levite.
- (Deuteronomy 15) Law of the Debts.
 - ★ NOTE the “if” in verse 5
 - ★ (vv. 7-8, 11) “Open wide your hand to the poor”
 - ★ (vv. 1-2, 9-10) Year of Release - every seven years
- (Deuteronomy 15:12-18) Law of Slaves
 - ★ (vv. 14-15) WHAT THE LORD HAS BLESSED YOU WITH!
- (Deuteronomy 15:19-23) Law of Firstborn
 - ★ (v. 21) Do not offer an offering with a defect - contrast with Malachi 1:7-8.
- (Deuteronomy 16) Law of the Feasts
 - ★ (vv. 16-17) Three times a year all males must go to Jerusalem during the feasts.
- (Deuteronomy 16:18-22) Law of the Administration of the Judges
 - ★ Perverting justice, taking bribes.
- (Deuteronomy 17 & 19) Law of Witnesses
 - ★ (vv6-7) Death penalty requires a minimum of TWO WITNESSES.
 - ☆ Consider Matthew 18:16



- (Deuteronomy 17) Law of the Administration of the King
 - ★ BEFORE there was a king God gave laws concerning the king!!!!
 - ★ The Laws concerning kings:
 - ① (v. 16) He shall not multiply his horses (army).
 - ② (v. 17) He shall not multiply wives for himself **lest his heart is turned away.**
 - ③ (v. 17) He shall not greatly multiply silver and gold for himself.
 - ④ (v. 18) He, himself, shall make a copy of the Law.
 - ⑤ (v. 19) He shall read the Law all the days of his life **that he may learn to fear the LORD his God and be careful to observe ALL the words of the Law . . . that his heart many not be lifted above his brethren, that he may not turn aside from commandment, that his life may be prolonged.**
- (Deuteronomy 18) Law of the Administration of Priest and Prophet
 - ★ (vv. 1-8) The tithes are to take care of God’s workmen.
 - ★ (vv. 9-13) Do not learn the ways of nations (world.)
 - No witchcraft, soothsayers, interpreting omens, no sorcerers, spells, mediums, spiritist, or one who calls up the dead – all of these are an **abomination** in the eyes of God.
 - ★ (vv. 15-19) God will raise up a prophet (Christ) and anyone who does not listen to Him God will require it of him.
- (Deuteronomy 19) Law of the Cities of Refuge
 - ★ Sanctuary for manslaughter. There was no sanctuary for premeditated murder.
 - ★ The Cities of Refuge are a picture of Christ - our Refuge; our High Priest.
- (Deuteronomy 20) Law of Warfare
 - ★ MEDITATE on the first word “When . . .”
- (Deuteronomy 21) Law of Unknown Murder
 - ★ MEDITATE: **Even unknown murder had to be atoned for!!!**
- (Deuteronomy 21 & 22) Law of Marriage
- (Deuteronomy 21) Law of Rebellious Son
- (Deuteronomy 22) Law of the Brother’s Property



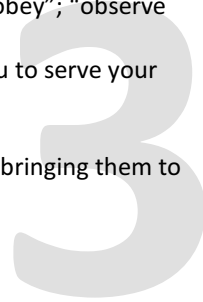
- (Deuteronomy 22) Law of Separation
 - ★ Man and women’s clothing
 - ★ Sowing seed in the fields
 - ★ Ox and donkey
 - ★ Garment of different materials
 - ★ Tassels
- (Deuteronomy 22) Law of Marriage
 - (vv. 13-21) Proof of virginity
 - (vv. 22-30) Rape and responsibilities
- (Deuteronomy 23) Law of Acceptance into the Congregation
 - (vv. 21-23) Making a vow - The LORD requires that we keep our word. (See Ecclesiastes 5:4-5)
- (Deuteronomy 23) Law of Harmony in the Nation
- (Deuteronomy 24:1-5) Law of Newly-Weds and War
- (Deuteronomy 24:6-22) Various laws: kidnapping, taking pledges, leprosy, oppression of hired workers, one dies for his/her own sins
- (Deuteronomy 24) Various Laws
- (Deuteronomy 25:1-3) Law of Immediate Punishment
- (Deuteronomy 25:5-10) Law of Continuing the Name of the Family
- (Deuteronomy 25:11-19) Various Laws: Touching another man’s genitals, honest business practices. **NOTE:** Dishonest business practices are an abomination to the LORD.
- (Deuteronomy 26) Law of the Tithe
- (Deuteronomy 26) Vow of Israel and of God Concerning the Covenant

Proclamation of Curses (Deuteronomy 27)

- (v. 26) “Cursed in the one who does not confirm all the words of this law.” And the people said, “Amen”.

Promised Blessings & Curses (Deuteronomy 28)

- (vv. 1- 14) Promised Blessings - note the words “if”, “diligently obey”; “observe carefully”; “all”
- (vv. 15-68) Promised Curses - note the words “if”; “obey”; “observe carefully”; “all”; **“The LORD will . . .” (14x)**
- IF you do not obey **with gladness** God will cause you to serve your enemies! (v. 47)
- NOTE the seriousness of God’s Word - vv. 53-62.
- (v. 63) God will **rejoice** in destroying His people and bringing them to nothing!



God's Grace Is Necessary for Fulfillment of the Covenant

(Deuteronomy 29)

- (v. 4) A heart (mind, will, emotions) must be given by God for anyone to fulfill covenant responsibilities.
- (vv. 5-9) **THEREFORE, keep the words of this covenant and do them .**
..
- (vv. 10-14) **Parties** of the Covenant.
- ★ ★ **READ CAREFULLY: Deuteronomy 29:19-28!!!!**
- (v. 29) Secret and revealed things of God.

Restoration of Israel (Deuteronomy 30)

- NOTE: The scattering of Israel was ALREADY known to God!!!!
MEDITATE!
- (vv. 6-8) God gives people NEW HEARTS (hearts that are circumcised) so that they will LOVE and OBEY Him!
- (vv. 9-10) NOTE carefully the "if" in verse 10.
- (vv. 11-20) Ratification of the Covenant

Moses Charges Joshua and Israel (Deuteronomy 31:1-13)

The Song of Moses (Deuteronomy 31:14-32:47)

- (Deuteronomy 31:14-21) God gave this to Moses for the purpose of **witnessing against** His people **when** they had "grown fat and turn to other gods and serve them and provoke God to anger . . ."
- (Deuteronomy 31:22-30) Moses calls "heaven and earth to witness against the people".
- (Deuteronomy 32:1-43) The Song of Moses written by God.
 - Testimony about their **coming** rebellion, disobedience, and utter corruption.
 - **MEDITATE on vv. 39-42**

Moses Views the Promised Land from Nebo

(Deuteronomy 32:48-52)

Moses Blesses the Tribes of Israel (Deuteronomy 33)

Moses Dies (Deuteronomy 34)

- (vv. 1-8, 10-12) Moses' death.
- (v. 9) Joshua replaces Moses.
