- In chapter 33: 42 times

We Are Pilgrims

- (Hebrews 11:13-16) We have a goal/end - “the Fatherland”.
 - ★ Their faith was REAL - they “saw”! (See John 5:56; Hebrews 11:25-27; Job 42:5)
- (Philippians 3:20-21) Our citizenship is not here but in heaven.
- (1 Peter 2:9-11) Who we were; Who we are; What we must beware of.

Tents Now; Buildings Next (2 Corinthians 5:1-4)

- Our bodies are compared to tents, but our hope is in a building.
- Are you groaning as verse 2 says?
- **MEDITATE:** 2 Peter 1:12-15. Be sure to define the immediate “these things” in verse 12.
 - Peter does not fear death.
 - ★ Peter wants to be used by God all the way up to death - even in prison.
 - ★ Peter’s faith does not wane though he finds himself in prison despite having served the Lord faithfully.
 - ★ Peter’s thoughts are not of himself but of OTHERS!
 - Christians live for others and not themselves.

They Watched, Listened and Followed!

- (Numbers 9:15-23) “at the command of the LORD” - they **watched** the cloud and pillar of fire. They **followed** to cloud. (See John 10:26-29)
- (Numbers 10:1-10) They **listened** for the trumpet and moved at its call. (See verses 5-6)
