Course Requirements

Tools to be brought to class:

- Any "Crisis of Belief" must be worked through using God's Word to solve it or them.

Read, Study, Learn and DO

- We will be studying with the purpose of changing our doing! (James 1:22)
- We will **exercise** what we have learned. (Hebrews 5:12-13)
- As we prayed (sang) . . .
 - Give me one pure and holy passion
 - Give me one magnificent obsession
 - Jesus give me one glorious ambition for my life
 - To know and follow hard after You
- . . . we will use the means that God has given us to go to higher ground!

Primary Presupposition

- The Bible is the Word of God, and therefore, TRUTH.
- **From HIBC's Statement of Faith:** We believe the Scriptures, both Old and New Testament, are the inspired Word of God. God so superintended the human authors that while retaining their own individual personalities and writing styles they chose the very words that God intended. Their original writings were free from error. The Bible is the believer's only infallible rule for faith and **practice** (living). We believe that the Bible supercedes even this statement of faith. (Psalm 19:7-9; 1 Corinthians 2:13; 2 Timothy 3:15-17; 2 Peter 1:20, 21)
